Ned has finally decided to admit that he's not the only one making music onstage. This is also Ned's first opportunity to take his band on tour with him, so he thought it appropriate to introduce them.

The two handsome cats who typically accompany Ned are drum extraordinaire Bret Porter, and bassist Tom Jensen. How does a duo get a trio label? Let us not forget the magnificent upright stringed Bass, "Daphne."

In 2001 Ned asked Bret Porter



to join him and now says, "Bret is the perfect drummer for any songwriter, as he really plays what is appropriate for the song instead of pursuing his own agenda."

Tom Jensen joined the group in 2004 after performing with Ned in Idaho's Gene Harris Jazz festival. "I instantly knew a trio with him and Bret would sound great. He is an amazing String Bassist, has incredible ears, and is an accomplished composer."
